What is ransomware? Ransomware is an advanced type of malware that infects your computer, gains control of your files and restricts your access until you pay a ransom to have your files restored.

- 1: Keep your antivirus and firewall up-to-date! To prevent malicious activity on your computer, maintain a strong firewall and keep your antivirus software current.
- 2: Enable your pop-up blocker! To minimize the chance of accidentally clicking on an infected ad, enable your browser's pop-up blocker.
- **3: Click carefully!** Think twice when opening emails from an unknown sender (check the sender's email address).
- **4:** Be cautious downloading content! Even though you can download anything you want to watch, listen or use, not all websites are safe and they may infect your device with malware.
- **5: Backup your files regularly!** To ensure your photos, contacts and important files are safe, regularly back them up to an alternative location such as another device, a USB or online file storage.
