#### BLACKFOOT IN EDUCATION



Education is a primary focus at Blackfoot, and this year we ramped up our efforts to provide more than \$100,000 in financial support through several initiatives.

- Easy Access: This free program was developed to help our cooperative member-owners learn basic computer skills. In 2017, Blackfoot provided 18 classes in 9 communities. Look for our fall schedule in early 2018.
- August Institute: Blackfoot was the premiere sponsor of this technology conference for educators held at The University of Montana in August. We provided scholarships for over 80 teachers from our rural schools to attend.
- **EEE Program:** A partnership with Blackfoot, Missoula Electric Coop and Energy Partners, the EEE Program provides funding for classroom technology across our shared service areas. Students and teachers attended an awards luncheon in November where over \$30,000 was awarded to local schools.

- Blackfoot Scholarship Fund: Scholarships for cooperative area students to support their post-secondary education. Recipients are invited to our annual cooperative meeting to receive acknowledgment for their hard work.
- Foundation for Rural Services Scholarship: Blackfoot provides an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C. for two students to learn first-hand about our government.

1) Innovation Symposium: CEO, Jason Williams was chosen to participate one-on-one with Governor Steve Bullock in a Fireside Chat at this year's Innovate Montana Symposium in Billings. The conference connects entrepreneurs with the resources they need to succeed under the Big Sky. Attendees learned about Blackfoot's commitment to deliver broadband products and services to foster innovation and economic success in our service areas.

2) Montana High Tech Jobs Summit: Blackfoot was a key sponsor of the Montana High Tech Jobs Summit in October. The biennial summit, co-hosted by Senator Steve Daines and the Montana Chamber of Commerce Foundation, brought together local and national tech leaders to discuss Montana's growing technology sector. The summit highlighted Montana's expanding role in our national high-tech economy and served as an opportunity to highlight Blackfoot's growing work force needs. During the Summit, Senator Daines toured the Blackfoot campus and data center to see our technology behind the scenes. In 2017, Blackfoot has hired over 20 high tech positions. 3) Facebook Showcases Blackfoot: In October, Facebook hosted a Boost Your Business event in Missoula. Blackfoot's Marketing Specialist, Lacey Hawkins, spoke on a local business panel and shared how engagement on social media has helped Blackfoot reach customers in a more meaningful way. Following the panel, Blackfoot was invited to be featured in a photo shoot. Facebook visited our Missoula campus in early November and photographed our operations in action. The Kauffman Index has ranked Montana first for startup business activity for four straight years.
