<p>As providers of interstate telecommunications services ("Services"), the Blackfoot family of companies ("Blackfoot") are required to contribute to the Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF), based on their sales of those Services. In turn, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) permits Blackfoot to recover its FUSF contributions from the purchasers of these Services in the form of FUSF charges. In some cases, however, purchasers of Blackfoot Services may be exempt from paying FUSF charges under the FCC rules. Services such as a circuit that begins and ends within the state and does not access services such as the Internet, or connect to long distance voice services, are examples of Services that would be exempt. This form is for you to certify your company's exempt status where the Service that company is purchasing is technically unable to access any service or areas that leave the state.</p> <p>By checking exempt below and signing I am certifying that the Service my company ("Customer") is purchasing is purely an intrastate circuit as described above.</p>
